of three hundred twenty six dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
edged have granted, bargained, sold and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell
and confirm unto the said Jordan Edwards an certain tract or parcel of land containing two
hundred seven acres more or less and bounded as follows. by the land of Andy Corp, Leml Chellette
George Kemp, and the said Jordan Edwards. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract
a parcel of land to the only proper uses and behoof of him the said Jordan Edwards
to him and his heirs forever and I the said Randolph Fowler do for myself my heirs & assigns
for ever warrant and defend the just right and title of any person or persons whatever unto
Jordan Edwards to him and his heirs & assigns forever. In witness whereof I have hereunto set

hundred & forty two between Solomon Johnson & Eliza Johnson his wife of the first part and Henry Fowler
of the second part. Witnesseth that the said Solomon Johnson and Eliza his wife in consideration
of the sum of fifty ^{three} dollars current money to them in hand paid by the said Henry Fowler at the
Sealing and delivering of these presents. the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said
Solomon Johnson & Eliza his wife, have bargained & sold, and by the present, do and will each of
them doth bargain and sell unto the said Henry Fowler all the reversionary interest as well as all
and every other interest to which the said Solomon Johnson and Eliza his wife may have in &
to a certain tract of land now held by Elizabeth Johnson as her dower in the land of the late
Ichabod Johnson with every part and parcel of said reversionary right or interest in remainder
and also their Interest in reversion or remainder to the slaves held by the said Elizabeth Johnson,
as her dower in the slaves of the aforesaid Ichabod Johnson to wit Pompey, Ben & Remey. To
have and to hold said land or interest in remainder or reversion in and to the same and also
to like interest in said slaves with the future increase of the female unto him the said Henry Fowler
his heirs Executors and Administrators forever. And they the said Solomon Johnson and Eliza his
wife will for themselves and their heirs, the aforesaid right and interest in remainder forever warrant
