In consideration of four hundred dollars (lawful money) of this Commonwealth in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said James I Scott at the sealing and delivery of these presents have bargained & sold and by these presents do bargain & sell unto the said James I Scott his heirs and assigns the tract of land wherein the aforementioned Daniel W Scott was residing being the tract set forth in the abovesaid deed of trust and containing by estimation two hundred acres more or less together with the reversion & reversions remainder & remainders with the yearly and other rents issues & profits with every part & parcel thereof and the said James D Wapenburg as trustee has for the further consideration of thirty five dollars bargained and sold unto the said James I Scott one parcel more to have and to hold paid tract of land with the tenements and all and singular the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and also said parcel more unto him the said James I Scott his heirs and assigns forever.
