to go, together with the increase or offspring thereof and one some more together with the increase or offspring thereof, he the said party of the first part, hereby consenting & agreeing that he the said party of the second part shall for and during the term of his natural life, possess, use, and enjoy the above described personal property, saving and reserving to himself the said party of the first part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, the right & title, possession, use and enjoyment of the said personal property as aforesaid, to take effect from and after the death of him the said party of the second part; and this Indenture being upon the further and express provision, that if the present or the subsequent creditors of the said party of the second part, or any of them, or any present or subsequent purchaser or purchasers, from and under the said party of the second part, or any other person or persons whatsoever, shall make or attempt to make claim, in any manner whatsoever, to the above described personal property, or any articles thereof, then and in such event, this Indenture and the loan hereby made shall be utterly void and of no effect, and the said personal property and each and every article thing shall, therefore forthwith, be returned to the possession of the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns. Williams of the County aforesaid of the other part. Whereby for and in consideration of the just sum of Four hundred dollars by the said James I. Williams in hand paid unto the said James Drake, and of the said James Drake doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and forever discharge the said James I. Williams, his heirs, assigns forever and by these presents the said James Drake hath granted bargained, sold & confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell, unto the said James I. Williams, one certain tract or parcel of Land and premises situated lying and being in the aforesaid County and bounded by the land of Alfred Ricks, Elijah Bryer, Nattie Brown, and Jesse Blythe and others containing two hundred and thirty eight acres more or less together with all the privileges and appurtenances to the said Land in any wise appertaining & belonging to have and to hold the above granted premises to the said James I. Williams his heirs, assigns forever, and the said James Drake doth by these presents covenant and grant to and with the said James I. Williams his heirs, and that he will by these presents warrant and defend against all rights, titles, claims or demands of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof, in witness whereof the said James Drake hath hereunto set his hand and seal this day and date above written
