assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land in County of Southampton, and bounded as follows, on  
the south by Benjamin Branch East by John Warren, north by Bennett P Stephenson, west  
by Emma Branch, south west by round Hill Swamp, containing by the old Survey .85 acres to  
the same more or less. Together with all and the reversion and reversions remainder & remainders  
yearly and other rents, issues and profits thereof, and of every part and parcel thereof to have  
and to hold, the said tract or parcel of land of .85 acres to the same more or less  
with the improvements, hereditaments and all and singular other the premises herein before  
mentioned, or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with  
ways of his right members and appurtenances unto the said Allen Stephenson his heirs  
et cetera for ever. And the said Alfred J Stephenson for himself and his heirs and assigns  
the said tract or parcel of land with all singular the premises and appurtenances before

THIS INDENTURE made and entered into this 19<sup>th</sup> day of December 1842 between  
William Cobb of the first part and John M Burley of the second part. Witnesseth: That  
the said William Cobb, in consideration of the sum of ten dollars to him in hand paid by the  
said John M Burley at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell  
unto the said John M Burley his heirs and assigns a certain lot of land, lying about 2 miles  
west of Jerusalem and bounded as follows. commencing at a large pine stump nearly in front  
of Nancy Turner or Gardner house, thence about 30 or 40 yards west, thence about 70 or 80  
yards south to a small sweet gum bush, thence about 80 or 90 yards east to the dividing  
line between said Cobb and the said Turner or Gardner, thence north about 80 or 90 yards to the  
beginning, supposed to contain about one acre be the same more or less. To have and to hold  
the said tract or lot of land, herein before mentioned, unto said John M Burley his  
heirs and assigns forever. And the said William Cobb do for himself, his heirs, the said lot of  
land and premises, before mentioned unto the said John M Burley his heirs and assigns  
free from the claim or claims of him the said William Cobb, his heirs, and of all & every
