To have and to hold to the said negro slave Sam. to the only proper use and behoof of the said Augustus W Hart his Executors administrators and assigns forever. And I the said Edwin G Hart for myself my Executors and administrators, the said negro slave to the said Augustus W Hart his Executors administrators and assigns against me the said Edwin G Hart my Executors administrators assigns, and against all and every other person and persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant forever defend by these presents. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 19th day of December 1842

And I the said Augustus W Hart for myself my Executors administrators and assigns against the claim of him the said Augustus W Hart his Executors administrators and assigns against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents.
