Know all men by these presents that I Sally Hunt of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear unto my children and for their better preferment in marriage and the increase of their portion and also in commendation of the sum of one dollar to me in hand paid by said children namely Mary Hunt, Elizabeth Hunt and John Hunt at and before the sealing & delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge hath given granted bargained & sold by their presents to give grant bargain and sell unto my said children all the goods and chattels following to wit and first I give to my daughter Mary Hunt at my death my first choice bed and furniture and best spinning wheel & cards one loom and great best chest three best bedding ~~chairs~~ best pot and spider best table one looking glass best bamboo best tub & tray. Secondly I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Hunt to wit second choice of beds and furniture second choice of tables and all my earthenware & one trunk one pot & spider second choice half a set of knives and forks two bedding ~~chairs~~ second choice. and first I give one flat iron one shovel and tongs three tubs one tray one bundle thirdly I give to my son John Hunt one bed and furniture third choice one chest third choice all this property I hold my life unless I see proper to give it up before and if one or more of the children should die without an heir I wish the property to go to the others or all those goods & chattels mentioned and expressed in the schedule or writing hereunto annexed to have and to hold all & singular the premises hereby given and granted unto the said children there use enjoy & admit forever within and then our property goods and chattels.
