Know all men by these presents that I Sally Hunt of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear unto my children and for their better preferments in marriage and the increase of their portion and also in consideration of the sum of one dollar to me in hand paid by said children namely Mary Hunt, Elizabeth Hunt and John Hunt at and before the sealing & delivery hereof the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge hath given granted bargained & sold & by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto my said children all the goods and chattels following to wit (and first) I give to my daughter Mary Hunt at my death my first choice bed and furniture and best Spinning wheel & cards one loom and gear best chest three best setting chairs best pot and spider best table one looking glass best bamboo best tub & tray. Secondly I give unto my daughter Elizabeth Hunt house, second choice of beds and furniture second choice of tables and all my earthenware of one trunk property spider green chair half a set of knives and forks two setting chairs second chair, and grid iron one flat iron, one shovel and tongs two tubs one tray one combbox thirdly I give to my son John Hunt one bed and furniture third choice one chest third chairs all the property I hold my life ample I do prospect to give it up before and if one or more of the children should die without an heir I wish the property to go to the others or all those goods & chattels mentioned and expressed in the Schedule or writing hereto annexed to have and to hold all yeaing also the premises hereby given and granted unto the said children there executing & admiring forever as their and their own property goods and chattels In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 14th day of December eighteen hundred and forty two
