This deed of bargain & sale from Thomas Everett & wife to Russell Everett was proved by the oaths of James Maget & Alex Myrick, two of the witnesses thereto, and in the Clerks Office the 24th day of Decr 1842 this deed was acknowledged by Thomas Everett a party thereto and together with the certificate of the prior examination & acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

By this INDENTURE made this 19th day of July in the year of Christ one thousand eight hundred and forty two between Mills D'ummer & Nancy I his wife of the first part; James H. Sebrell of the second part; and Nicholas M. Sebrell and Thomas C. Jones of the third part. Whereas the said Nicholas M. Sebrell and Thomas C. Jones, being bound as security to the said Mills D'ummer for a bond of seven hundred and three dollars due the 29th day of December 1841, payable to William J. Sebrell, one bond of one hundred and ninety seven due January 1st 1843 with interest from the 5th day of January 1842, payable to Iepo Drury; also one bond for three hundred dollars due the first day of January 1844, with interest from the 5th day of January 1842 payable to Iepo Drury. And whereas the said Mills D'ummer & Nancy I, his wife desirous to secure and hath agreed to secure the payment of the said debt and interest with all charges attending the same, or incurred by reason of the premises, by conveying the property hereinafter mentioned unto the said James H. Sebrell. In Trust, Now, therefore, This indenture witnesseth, that David Mills D'ummer & Nancy I, his wife in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar to them by the said trustee in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath bargained and sold, confirmed, assigned and made over; and do by these presents bargain and sell, confirm, assign and make over, unto the said James H. Sebrell, a tract or parcel of land situated in the County of Southampton containing three hundred and twelve acres more or less bounded as follows. North by the road leading from Jamesport to Suffolk East by the land of Joannah Williford & James Scott and South by Benj. Locking west by flaggy marsh To have and to hold the said land, abovementioned, unto the said James H. Sebrell his executors, administrators & assigns. In trust & upon condition, nevertheless, that the said James H. Sebrell will sell at any time after giving reasonable notice when required by the parties the said land to pay any part of the said debts for cash. And out of the proceeds in the first place to his charge all legal & usual costs and expenses attending the sale of the conveyance;
