To have and to hold the said land and appurtenances subject to the incumbrance aforesaid, and the personal property before mentioned to him the said ^{and his legal heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns} ~~W Mason~~ on being thereof required by the said creditor the said sums of money being due and unpaid shall proceed to sell the said tract of land subject to the incumbrance aforesaid, and the personal property before mentioned after duly advertising the time of sale for ten days at some public place in the County aforesaid on the premises sell on a credit of ten months, taking of the purchasers respectively bond with good security and shall pay first the expenses of this trust out of the proceeds and then pay to John W Mason two hundred and twenty dollars part of the debt first mentioned with interest thereon from the 25th day of December 1842, and the balance pay to the creditor pro rata and the surplus if any pay to the said Benjamin W Lewis.
