This Indenture made this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of December A.D. between Joseph H Parker  
and Susan T his wife of the one part and Solomon D Parker of the other part, witnesseth that the  
said Joseph H Parker and Susan T his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred  
and fifty dollars, the receipt whereof of the said Joseph H Parker & Susan T his wife do hereby  
acknowledge herein granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell unto  
the said Solomon D Parker, all their right title and interest (it being the half of a Water  
Crost Mill & fourteen acres of Land attached thereto, owned by the said Joseph H Parker &  
Solomon D Parker situated in the County of Southampton on the Norwell Swamp. To have and to hold the said  
interest in said Mill & Land with the appurtenances unto the said Solomon D Parker his  
heirs and assigns, and also all the right title and interest whatever of them the said Joseph  
H Parker and Susan T his wife in and to the said Mill & Land to the proper use & behoof of  
him the said Solomon D Parker his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Joseph H Parker &  
Susan T his wife for them selves and their heirs, free from the claim or claims of all and every per-  
son or persons whatsoever will warrant and by these presents forever defend. In witness whereof  
the said Joseph H Parker and Susan T his wife have hereunto set their hands & affixed  
their seals this day and year first above written
