hundred and forty three between Mason Cobb of the first part and John M. Cobb of the second
part all of the County of Southampton County and State of Va. Witnesseth that the said Mason
Cobb has for and in Consideration of the sum of Ten dollars the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
unconditionally bargained and sold and do by these presents bargain and sell unto the said John M.
Cobb his heirs and assigns my life right in a certain tract and parcel of land containing thirty
acres lie it more or less and is bounded by Simon Murphy land and the land of David Cobb
descried as being the tract and parcel of land the Commissioners allotted to me the said Mason Cobb
of my deceased husband to have and to hold the aforesaid tract and parcel of land my life right
the said Mason Cobb doth hereby warrant and will defend the aforesaid premises with all
the cession and reversions remainder & remainders yearly and other rents unto the said John
M. Cobb his heirs and assigns the said right free from all the claims or claims demands or
demands of all and every person whomsoever in testimony whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and affixed my seal this day and year as is above written.

Know all men by these presents that we William S. Everett Edwards Butts W.M.
Deb ill Robert Ricks Nichols on behalf of Clements Rockelle are held and firmly bound
unto James McDowell Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of
Thirty thousand dollars to be paid to the said Governor and his successors in the office of Governor
for the use of the Commonwealth: for the payment whereof well & truly to be made we bind
ourselves and each of us, our and each of our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and
severally, by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this 16th day of January 1843.
The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound William S. Everett
is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission from John
M. Gregory Lieutenant Governor, acting as Governor pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution
under the Seal of the Commonwealth, dated the twenty ninth day of November 1842, it shall
be for the said William S. Everett shall well and truly collect and receive all office
