bargained and sold and do by these presents bargained and sell unto the said John McCobb
his heirs and assigns my life right in a certain tract and parcel of land containing thirty
acres be it more or less and is bounded by Simon Murrell and the land of David Cobb
dec'd. & being the tract and parcel of land the Commission is letted to me the said Mason Cobb
of my dec'd. husband to have and to hold the aforesaid tract and parcel of land my life right
the said Mason Cobb doth hereby warrant and will defend the aforesaid premises with all
the reversion and reversions, remainders & remainders yearly and other rents unto the said John
McCobb his heirs and assigns the said right free from all the claims or claims demands or
demands of all and every person whomsoever in testimony whereof I have hereunto set
my hand and affixed my seal this day and year as is above written.

ourselves and each of us, our, and each of our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and
severally, firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated the 16th day of January 1843.
The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound William L Everett
is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission from John
McGregory Lieutenant Governor, acting as Governor pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution
under the Seal of the Commonwealth dated the twenty ninth day of November 1842. If he
before the said William L Everett shall well and truly collect and receive all officers
