Know all men by these presents that we William L Everett Edwards Esq^r William I Seabree Robert Ricks Nicholas W Seabree & Clements Rochelle are held and firmly bound unto James M Duvall Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of Thirty thousand dollars to be paid to the said Governor and his Successors in the Office of Gov^r for the use of the Commonwealth for the payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves and each of us our and each of our heirs Executors administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 16th day of January A.D. 1863.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound William L Everett is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission from John M Engory Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor pursuant to the provisions of the Constitution under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the twenty ninth day of November 1862 If therefore the said William L Everett shall well and truly collect all taxes & poor rates and account for and pay the same in such manner as is by law directed and also all fines for forfeitures and amercements accruing or becoming due to the Commonwealth in the said County and shall duly account for and pay the same to the Treasurer of the Commonwealth within the time being for the use of the Commonwealth in like manner as is or shall be directed in case of public taxes and shall in all things truly & faithfully execute the said Office of Sheriff during his continuance therein then the above obligation to be void, or else to remain in full force and virtue.
