This Indenture made this 24th day of December in the year of our Lord
 one thousand eight hundred and forty two between Edwin Gardner & Elizabeth his wife
 of the first part. Alfred T Stephenson of the second part, and Jeppe S Bailey & James A.
 Kello of the third part, whereas the said Jeppe S Bailey & James A. Kello having become
 bound with the said Edwin Gardner as security for the sum of three hundred & twenty
 one dollars 56² cents, the said Edwin Gardner & Elizabeth his wife is willing & desirous to
 secure the said Jeppe S Bailey & James A. Kello as his security to ten bonds bearing
 date the day of December 1842, which by reference to said bonds will more fully appear
 Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in Consideration of one dollar to him in
 hand paid by the said Alfred T Stephenson at or before the concluding and delivery of
 these presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, they the said Edwin Gardner
 and Elizabeth his wife, has given, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released
 and confirmed, and by these presents does give grant, bargain sell, alien enfeoff, lease
 and confirm to the said Alfred T Stephenson his heirs and assigns forever, All that
 tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton formerly held
 by Bernicia Clayton containing one hundred & fifty acres be the same more or less, and bounded
 as follows by the land of Marmaduke A Branch, James Drury and round hill swamp also all
 his hogs, cows, crop of corn & other, brandy peas & potatoes &c that may be found at the houses
 or on the land when default of payment be made, with all and singular the appurtenances to the
 tract of land belonging or in any wise appertaining and all the right title & interest of them the
 said Edwin Gardner and Elizabeth his wife in and to the said granted or intended to be hereby
 granted tract of land and premises, together with all my crops, to have and to hold the same
 with its premises and appurtenances unto the said Alfred T Stephenson his heirs Executors
 and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Alfred T Stephenson
 heirs &c, and the said Edwin Gardner and Elizabeth his wife for them their Execs &c do
 do hereby covenant promise and agree to and with the said Alfred T Stephenson his heirs Executors
 &c in manner and form following, that the said Edwin Gardner & Elizabeth his wife their
 heirs of the aforesaid land and premises with its appurtenances unto the said Alfred T Stephenson
 his execs against all persons who ever shall, will and does warrant and forever defend by these
 presents. Upon Trust nevertheless that the said Alfred T Stephenson his heirs &c
 shall permit the said Edwin Gardner & Elizabeth his wife to remain in quiet & peaceable
 possession of the said tract of land and premises with the appurtenances, and take the
 profits of the same to their use until default be made in the payment of the
 said debt by bonds due to Shugars & Ann Adams of John Holmes, either in whole or in
 part and then upon this further trust that he, the said Alfred T Stephenson his heirs
 execs &c shall and will so soon after the happening of such default of payment as he or
 they may think proper, or the said Jeppe S Bailey & James A. Kello their execs or son
 may direct, sell the said tract of land and premises with the appurtenances and crops
 on said land or so much thereof as may be deemed sufficient by the said Alfred T
 Stephenson to discharge the said debt and costs attending the same, to the highest
 bidder for ready money, or upon such time as the parties interested may agree
