This deed of trust between Edwin Gardner & wife of the first part, Alfred T Stephenson of the second part, Jesse L Bailey & James A McKello of the third part was acknowledged by Edwin Gardner, Stephenson, Bailey & McKello four of the parties thereto and admitted to Record Teste L R Edwards &c

This Indenture made and entered into this 11th day of January 1843 between Susan Hines of the first part William J Seabell of the second part and Edwards Butts of the third part, all of the County of Southampton, Wiltshire, that whereas the said Susan Hines is justly indebted unto the said Edwards Butts in the sum of twenty dollars & four cents by bond on demand the 11th day of January 1843, and also the said Butts has become secur security to several forthcoming or delivery bonds taken upon execution sued out from the Clerks Office of the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for Southampton County, that is to say one of said executions in favour of William Thornton late Sheriff & administrator with the will annexed of John Davis dec^d against Susan Hines & Saml M Hines another in favour of William Parker who sue for the benefit of Howell A Atkins, against Susan Hines & Samuel B Hines, another in favour of H A Atkins against Susan Hines another in favour of Wm Parker against Susan Hines, another in favour of Hangrave & Chappell, merchants & partners trading under the said firm style, against Susan Hines another in favour of John M Myoke against Susan Hines, and also the said Butts is security for the said Susan Hines in a bond executed to Henry Pettway & James E Peters for the sum of one hundred & four dollars on demand October the 11th 1843, and likewise in a bond executed to L R Edwards & Thos J Gholson for the sum of one hundred and forty nine dollars & sixty cents, and on demand the first day of October 1843, and whereas also the said Susan Hines has heretofore executed two deeds of Trust, that is to say one on the 31st day of January 1842, and admitted to Record in the Clerks Office of Southampton County on the 7th day of February 1842, for the purpose of securing the payment of a debt therein mentioned due the said Edwards Butts, the other dated on the 28th day of October 1842 and admitted to Record in the Clerks Office aforesaid on the 29th day of October 1842 for the purpose of securing a debt due from Samuel B Hines & Susan Hines his security to Edwards Butts adm^r &c of Peter Broth D^r.
