This Indenture made this 13<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred  
Eighty three between Phineas M Bailey of Southampton County State of Virginia of the first part  
St Joseph Britton of Surry County of second part & George B Holloman of Southampton  
County of third part. Witnesseth that whereas the said Phineas M Bailey is indebted to  
William B Holloman for two hundred & fourteen dollars 38<sup>05</sup> to Gray barrel in the  
sum of eighty eight dollars 89 cents & James Clayton in the sum of Ninety five dollars 31<sup>c</sup>  
the said amounts the said George B Holloman is bound for security of the said P M Bailey  
wishing to secure him the said Geo B Holloman and in consideration of the sum of one dollar  
in hand paid by the said Joseph Britton, at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said P M Bailey hath granted bargained and  
sold & by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the said Joseph Britton his heirs & assigns  
the land & Plantation belonging to the said P M Bailey containing Eleven hundred & eighty one  
acres be the same more or less, bounded as follows to w<sup>n</sup> on the north by Robert Britton on the west  
by Thomas Atkins & Lavinia Work on the south by George B Holloman & John Virginard on the  
East by James B Virginard and Jos Briford, to have & to hold the said land & plantation with all  
its appurtenances, unto the said Jo Britton his heirs & assigns forever upon Trust, Witnesseth  
if the said Jo Britton should be called on to make the money named above to said Holloman  
barrel & Clayton then & in that case it shall be lawful for the said Joseph Britton after  
giving ten days notice of such sale proceed to sell for cash the above named land & plant-  
ation and after discharging the above mentioned debts with interest & cost and all reasonable expence  
of such sale pay the overplus if any, to the said P M Bailey or his legal representatives. In
