This Indenture made this 13th day of January in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred & forty three between Phineas M. Bailey of Southampton County State of Virginia of the first part Joseph Butters of Surry County of Second part & George B. Holleman of Southampton County of third part. Witnesseth that whereas the said Phineas M. Bailey is indebted to William B. Holleman for two hundred & fourteen dollars 38^{cts} to Gray Carroll in the sum of eighty eight dollars 89 cents & James Clayton in the sum of ninety five dollars 31^{cts} the said unto the said George B. Holleman is bound for as security & the said P. M. Bailey nothing to secure him the said Geo B. Holleman and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid by the said Joseph Butters at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said P. M. Bailey hath granted bargained and sold & by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the said Joseph Butters his heirs & assigns the land & Plantation belonging to the said P. M. Bailey containing Eleven hundred & Eighty one acres be the same more or less, bounded as follows to wit on the north by Robert Butters on the west by Thomas Atkins & Lerina Hunt on the south by George B. Holleman & John V. V. on the east by James B. V. and Jos. P. P. to have & to hold the said Land & Plantation with all its appurtenances, unto the said Jos. Butters his heirs & assigns forever upon Trust, Witnesseth if the said Jos. Butters should be called on to make the money named above to said Holleman Carroll & Clayton then & in that case it shall be lawful for the said Joseph Butters after giving two days notice of such sale proceed to sell for Cash the above named Land & Plantation and after discharging the above mentioned debts with interest & cost and all reasonable expenses of such sale pay the surplus if any, to the said P.
