This Indenture made and entered into this 21st day of January 1840 between Daniel
 Fowler of the County of Southampton of the first part, John R Williams of the said County & Nelson
 B Gardner of the County of Isle of Wight of the 2^d part all of the State of Virginia. Whereas the said
 Daniel Fowler is justly indebted to the said Nelson B Gardner in the sum of forty dollars
 due by note and bearing date March 1837. Also one note due Hardy Corp for which the
 said N. B. Gardner is security for the sum of One hundred Eighty four dollars & fifty cts
 due December 31st 1837. Which debt the said Daniel Fowler is willing and desirous to
 secure. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for an inconsideration of the premises, for the
 further sum of one dollar to the said Daniel Fowler in hand paid by John R Williams
 at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
 ledged to the said Daniel Fowler hath given granted, bargained, sold and confirmed &
 by these presents doth give grant, bargain and sell unto the said John R Williams &
 his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County
 of Southampton whereon the said Daniel Fowler now resides. Also the following personal
 property to wit, Negro man Ben, Woman Fanny and Girl Delila also three feather bed
 and furniture, ten chairs, four tables, one chest and one trunk Two tubs one pot, one spider
 two pails one lot of Bacon, parcel of Corn and fodder two cows, one Steer, one sorrel horse
 three sows & Twenty two pigs, one cart & wheels, one Cast plough and two flocks hoes two axes
 one cider press, one apple mill and parcel of Barn^l and Casks. To have and to hold
 the said land and personal property to the said John R Williams his heirs & assigns
 forever and the said Daniel Fowler doth for himself his heirs and assigns hereby cove-
 nant promise and agree with the said John R Williams his heirs & assigns in manner and form
 as follows, i.e. the said Daniel Fowler his heirs & assigns doth warrant the title of the said prop-
 erty unto the said John R Williams his heirs & assigns Upon Trust nevertheless that the said
 John R Williams his heirs & assigns shall permit the said Daniel Fowler & assigns to remain in quiet
 possession of the aforesaid property until default be made in the payment of the said debt
 either in part or in the whole. There upon further trust that so soon as default be made
