I now all men by these presents, that I Phinias M Bailey & my wife Evelina B Bailey of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia for and in consideration of one hundred Dollars to us in hand paid, by John S Gwaltney of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge we have bargained, sold, granted, and confirmed to the said John S Gwaltney a certain parcel or lot of negroes, now in the possession of the said John S Gwaltney in right of his wife & their increase, To have and To hold the said negro slaves & their increase to the uses & benefit of the said John S Gwaltney his heirs, executors & administrators forever, and I the said Phinias M Bailey & my wife Evelina B Bailey our heirs executors & administrators the said parcel or lot of negroes with their increase to the said John S Gwaltney his heirs executors & administrators I the said Phinias M Bailey & my wife Evelina B Bailey our heirs executors & administrators & against all other person & persons whatsoever, shall & will warrant & forever defend by these presents.
