This Indenture made and entered into this first day of February 1843 between Joseph T Williams of the one part and William L Williams of the other part both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that whereas the said Joseph T Williams hath this day sold unto the said William L Williams all of his interest & title in a certain tract or parcel of land belonging to the heirs of Matthew Williams and bounded and described as follows. On the north by the lands of Robert Bick & Nicholas Williams. East by the lands of John Davis & Jethro Charles. South by the lands of Jethro Charles and west by the lands of John Davis & Robert Ricks. being and lying in the parish of Newway and County of Southampton. Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said Joseph T Williams for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said William L Williams (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents does grant bargain and sell unto the said William L Williams his heirs & assigns the said interest in the said tract of land including the interest of the said Joseph T Williams in the dower of the widow (Jane Bick) together with the appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining to the said interest in the said tract or parcel of land herein above mentioned and described. To have and to hold the said interest in the said above described tract or parcel of land & premises with their appurtenances unto him the said William L Williams his heirs & assigns forever. And the said Joseph T Williams hereby covenants to and with the said William L Williams his heirs & assigns that the said Joseph T Williams will warrant and defend the title to the premises hereby conveyed unto and for the said William L Williams his heirs & assigns against the right title claim & demand of him the said Joseph T Williams and the claiming by through or under him against the claim & demand of all and every other person or persons whatsoever - In Testimony whereof the said Joseph T Williams hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day & year first herein aforesaid.

Witnesseth that the said John W Reese being justly indebted to the said Sampson C Reese in the just and full sum of two hundred & seventy one dollars & twenty four cents due by bond bearing equal date with these presents, and on demand the same date, and the said Sampson C Reese having this day become security for the said John W Reese in a bond due to Peter Edwards Guardian for Next Harris orphan of Next Harris do^r for the sum of one thousand & twenty one dollars & fifty six cents due and on demand the 1st February 1843 also the said John W Reese being justly indebted to Nathaniel Francis in the just sum of One hundred & eighty seven dollars & 14⁰⁰ cents due by note bearing equal date
