This Indenture made and entered into this 7th day of February in the year 1843 between Benj. Brown (for) of the first part: Peter Edwards, John Whitehead, Nathaniel Jones of the second part & David W. Mason of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. (Witnesseth) That whereas the said Benj. Brown (for) stand justly indebted to Peter Edwards in the just and full sum of Forty one dollars & 87^{cs} due on demand the 7th February 1843 (and whereas the said Benj. Brown being justly indebted to W. D. Turner for the sum of twenty six dollars & 25^{cs} due by one note in demand as follows (viz) one for the sum of twenty six dollars & 25^{cs} due the 13th last then must (and the said John Whitehead & Nathaniel Jones having become his security for the same to the said the said W. D. Turner as by reference to said note will more fully appear) and being desirous and willing to secure the debt aforesaid to Peter Edwards (and save harmless the aforesaid John Whitehead from paying or in any way injured by said security) that on this day for and in consideration of the premises and for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him the said Benj. Brown (for) in hand paid at and before the making & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given, granted, bargained & sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said David W. Mason and to his heirs representatives & forever the following property (viz) one tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by recent survey One hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Adam Arter, & Henry Fingerson Nathaniel Jones Anthony Harris & Billy Brown (for) Together with all improvements thereunto attached of every description - Three head of horses, four head of cattle, stock of hogs, mules, bacon now on hand, & corn fodder together with my household furniture, farming utensils, two carts & wheels and every other proper that I am entitled to or interested in to him and his heirs forever, & I do by these presents warrant and forever defend the title of the aforesaid land & property hereby conveyed, or intended to be conveyed, and every part and parcel thereof unto him the said David W. Mason Upon the following trust nevertheless that the said David W. Mason shall suffer the said Benj. Brown (for) to remain in peaceable and quiet possession of the property consisting of land & other property hereby conveyed until he may be instructed by all or either of the parties to this deed and upon such
