 of two hundred & twenty one dollars and ninety three cents, due the twenty fifth day of last December
 for land rent and super hire for the year Eighteen hundred and forty two, also to secure the payment
 of Eighty Dollars due the twenty fifth day of next December for land rent ^{for rent} this year And further-
 more in order to save the said William Juddkins harmless from the payment of several sums of
 money for which the said William Juddkins is bound as my security, To W^{it}h two bonds to Content
 Juddkins, one for about the sum of seventy seven dollars, due June Eighteen hundred & forty one And
 the other for the sum of ninety nine dollars and five cents, due September Eighteen hundred & forty one
