in the sum of Five hundred and fifty two and forty cents, due by bond bearing date February 1st 1843, which debt the said Hardy Rawls is willing and desirous to pay, and is also desirous and willing to save him the said Abram Riddick himself (and free from damage by reason of the several Survey of ships now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand in hand paid by the said James M Rawls Trustee in the said Hardy Rawls hath given, granted and sold unto him the said James M Rawls the following property to wit: Vizt One Tract of land lying and being in the said County of Southampton and State of Virginia, and on which the said Hardy Rawls now lives, containing two hundred and twenty six acres more or less, and bounded by lands of Willis W. Lawrence, William Guy, Goodman & Johnson and William Ellis. One negro man named Henderson, one horse, five head of cattle, twenty head of hogs, ten sheep, two beds, steeds and furniture and all my other household furniture, all my cooking utensils, all my farming utensils, one loom and spindles, one cart, wheel & gear and all and every of my other property not specially named in this article, together with what crop of Corn, fodder &c I may raise on said land in the year 1843. To him the said James M. Rawls and his heirs forever, upon trust nevertheless that the said Hardy Rawls is to retain possession of the aforesaid property until required by the said James M Rawls trustee shall after advertising for ten days in three publick places in the County and neighbourhood proceed to sell for Cash, all the property named & intended to be understood as conveyed in this instrument and after paying off the aforesaid note of Five hundred & fifty two dollars and forty cents with interest from February 1st 1843, to Riddicks and said Riddicks open a/c to said Hardy Rawls for the year 1843, and all cost, pay over the balance to James Rawls bond of about Eighty dollars, Wm Edwards bond of about Forty five dollars and one other of Fourteen dollars, Meredith Holland bond of about Forty dollars, Jason Gardner bond of about Fifty dollars, G. Edwards bond of about Twenty dollars, Hardy Crops bond of about Fifteen dollars, John Jenkins bond of Thirty three dollars, Barnes & Rawls bond of about thirty dollars, Share and Share alike and if a balance should remain in the hands of said Trustee to pay it over to said Hardy Rawls.
