in the sum of Five hundred and fifty two and forty cents, due by bond bearing date February 1st 1843, which debt the said Hardy Rauls is willing and desirous the payment, and is also desirous several surety ships, now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand in hand paid by the said James M Rauls Trustee the following property to wit: Viz One Tract of land lying and being in the said County of Southampton and State of Virginia, and on which the said Hardy Rauls now lives, containing two hundred and twenty six acres more or less and bounded by lands of Willis W. Lawrence, William Gay, Goodman C Johnson and William Ellis. One negro man named Henderson, one horse, five head of cattle, twenty head of hogs, ten sheep, two loads stables and furniture and all my other household furniture, all my cooking utensils, all my farming utensils, one loom and fixtures, one cart, wheels & gear and all and every of my other property not specially named in this article, together with what crops of Corn, fodder &c I may raise on said land in the year 1843. To him the said James M Rauls and his heirs forever, upon trust nevertheless that the said Hardy Rauls is to retain possession of the aforesaid property until required by the said James M Rauls Trustee, shall after advertising for ten days in three publick places in the County and neighborhood proceed to sell for cash, all the property named & intended to be understood as conveyed in this instrument and after paying off the aforesaid note of Five hundred & fifty two dollars and forty cents with interest from February 1st 1843, to Middick and said Middick then a/c to said Hardy Rauls for the year 1843, and all cost, pay over the balance to James Rauls bond of about eighty dollars, Mrs V. Edwards bond of about Forty five dollars and one other of Fourteen dollars, Meredith Nettland bond of about Forty dollars, James Gardner bond of about Fifty dollars, J. Edwards bond of about Twenty dollars, Hardy Croft bond of about Fifteen dollars, John Jenkins bond of Thirty three dollars, Barnes & Rauls bond of about thirty dollars, share and share alike and if a balance should remain in the hands of said Trustee to pay it over to said Hardy Rauls.
