for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and forty four dollars & forty four cents  
to him in hand paid by the said Walter Myrick at and before the executing & delivery of  
these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained and sold and by  
these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Walter Myrick his heirs & assigns  
all his interest right and title in and to the lower estate of his Grand mother Mary Barrett  
widow of Jacob Barrett dec<sup>d</sup> consisting of two hundred & twenty acres of land now only  
whereon she now lives & twenty one negro men in her possession together with three increase his  
interest being one eighth part thereof. To have and to hold the said interest right & title  
or one eighth part of the said lower land and negroes to him the said Walter Myrick  
his heirs & assigns ad<sup>m</sup> a assign, and I the said James H. Barrett for myself my heirs & exec<sup>t</sup>  
administrators &c and will forever warrant and defend all the right and title in and to the said  
interest or one eighth part of the said lower interest of the land and negroes of the said  
Mary Barrett to him the said Walter Myrick his heirs ad<sup>m</sup> against the lawful claims  
of all persons whatsoever by these presents. Now witnesseth whereof the said James H. Barrett
