This Indenture made and executed this 21st of January A.D. one thousand eight hundred and forty three between Jacob Bryant and Temperance his wife of the one part and Allen Beale of the other part, all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that the said Jacob Bryant & Temperance his wife here for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars to them the said Jacob Bryant and Temperance his wife in hand paid by the said Allen Beale the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged bargain & sell and do by their presents bargain and sell, enjoin and confirm unto the said Allen Beale his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract and parcel of land containing by survey ten acres in Southampton County, and is bounded as follows Viz. Beginning at a small post on the corner of the tract and the said Jacob Bryant thence along a new line of marked trees between this tract and the said Jacob Bryant N 75° W 81 p. to the run of the great branch thence down the run of the said branch the various courses thereof 44 p. to a pine corner of this tract and Allen Beale, thence along the old line between this tract and the said Allen Beale the various courses thereof 84 p. to the beginning. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract and parcel of land forever. And the said Jacob Bryant and Temperance his wife do hereby warrant and will forever defend the aforesaid premises, with all the accretions & increments remaining & remainders of any and other lands, unto the said Allen Beale his heirs and assigns free from all the claim or claims demand or demands of all and every person whomsoever.
