This Indenture made and entered into on this 19<sup>th</sup> day of January one thousand eight  
hundred and forty three between William D Clark acting as trustee to a deed of trust executed  
by Barton Taylor for the benefit of Ben C Pope John Barkham Nathaniel B Bryan Henry Ingoldsby  
and James H. Cleveland of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and Leathbert D Barham  
of the same County and State, witnesseth that the said William D Clark trustee for and  
in consideration of the sum of six hundred & fifteen dollars to him in hand paid by the said  
Leathbert D Barham at or before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained sold and confirmed and do by these  
presents grant bargain sell and confirm unto him the said Leathbert D Barham his  
heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid  
County of Southampton containing two hundred and five acres to the same more or less adjoining  
the lands of the said Leathbert D Barham Mark D Pitt Henry Kindred George Williams  
and Ben C Pope. Together with all the right title interest claim or demand of and to the  
above described tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances thereto belonging  
unto him the said Leathbert D Barham his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only pur-  
pose and use of him the said Leathbert D Barham his heirs and assigns forever, and the  
said William D Clark trustee for himself his heirs and assigns doth hereby covenant with  
the said Leathbert D Barham his heirs and assigns that he will by these presents warrant and  
forever defend the right and title of the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises  
and every part or parcel thereof (so far as such right is vested in him as trustee) against the
