This Indenture made and entered into this 20th day of February In the year
 four and one thousand eight hundred and forty three, Between William G. Wilson
 P. Pope & Benjamin Pope and Jacob Barnes all of the County of Southampton & State of
 Virginia, Witnesseth that in the said William G. Wilson in order to secure the said
 Ben G. Pope the payment of one hundred & thirty one dollars and 63/100 also to secure the
 above name Jacob Barnes the payment of seventy five dollars both of which debts is justly
 due to the said Pope & Barnes, appearing by bond as well as this Indenture and of firm date
 hereunto, also the interest which shall accrue thereon and all reasonable costs of carrying
 this Indenture into effect and for the further consideration of one dollar to the said William
 G. Wilson in hand paid by the said Harrison P. Pope at or before the executing & delivery
 of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, in the said William G. Wilson
 hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain (and sell unto the said
 Harrison P. Pope all the tract or parcel of land whereon the said Wilson now lives, sufficed
 to contain seven or five acres to the same more or less also the tract or parcel of land in the
 said Wilson purchased of William S. & John R. Rochele containing by late survey thirty
 and 1/2 acres be the same more or less, also the following named personal property to wit
 three horses eight head cattle, thirty head hogs, six sheep, three carts & three pr. wheels one
 Apple mill and side press, forty side carts, six ploughs, four cowbells, four wood boxes
 two goat hors, three axes, three ploughs and traces one saddle, girdle one Prandy Still (and
 apparatuses, three beds and furniture twelve sitting chairs one clock, two desks four tables
 one of which is walnut, parcel of crockery tin and wood ware, three pots two ovens one Spade
 2 pr and iron, temp & shovel one pr and iron two pot castles two pr hocks twenty barrels corn
 and about two thousand pounds blade for a deer one Keg band two shot guns, salt knives
 forks and about one thousand pounds of Bacon, To have (and to hold all the above
 described property both real and personal, with all the right title interest and estate
 which he the said William G. Wilson has heretofore held in both real and personal property
 heretofore described to him the said Harrison P. Pope his heirs (and assigns forever, upon
 Trust, nevertheless, that he the said Harrison P. Pope at the request of either said
 Wilson or said Pope & Barnes, shall after giving reasonable notice say ten days or more
 to be advertised at three or more places in the neighbourhood of said property, sell at
 auction for cash all or so much of said property as shall be sufficient to pay and sat-
 isfy the before described debts, Interest and costs as aforesaid, and in case a surplus shall
 remain in the hands of the said Harrison P. Pope after paying the aforesaid debts into &
 costs the same shall be paid over by the said Harrison P. Pope to the said William G. Wilson
 or his legal representative, and in case any of the above named property shall remain unsold
 after the payment of the aforesaid debts Int. and costs it shall in that case be the
 duty of the said Harrison P. Pope to release said property if any, in witness whereof the parties
 herein have hereunto set their hand and affixed their seals the day and year first before written.
