This Indenture made this 10th day of November one thousand eight hundred
 and forty two, in and between Seth D Williams trustee for William M. Wells and
 Patsey Wells the wife of said Wm M. Wells of the first part of the County of South-
 ampton and State of Virginia. And Jep Parker of the same County & State,
 witnesseth, That the said Seth D Williams as trustee and Patsey Wells in her own
 right, for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and eighty nine dollars to
 them in hand paid the receipt of which is acknowledged by the said Jep Parker, hath
 bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain & sell unto the said Jep Parker
 his heirs or assigns, a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the said County of South-
 ampton containing one hundred and five acres more or less bounded by the lands
 of Jep Parker and others and the said Seth D Williams trustee
 for Wm M. Wells doth guarantee to the said Jep Parker all the right title interest
 of the said Wm M. Wells in the said tract or parcel of land to him the said
 Jep Parker his heirs and assigns forever, free from the claim of him the said Wm M.
 Wells or his heirs and I the said Patsey Wells doth for myself do the same. Given
