

This Indenture

made and entered into this the 15th day of February in the year
of our Lord 1843 between Edward Beaton and his wife Martha J Beaton of the one part
and John R. Rockelle of the other part, both of the County of Southampton and State
of Virginia (minimally) that the said Edward Beaton and his wife Martha J.
Beaton for and in Consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, Good
and Lawfull money to them in hand paid at and before the making and delivery of
these presents of the said John R. Rockelle the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath
given granted bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bar-
gain sell and confirm unto the said John R. Rockelle his heirs and assigns forever one
tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing
twenty acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows. Comprising at the Posts, I
smooth and Mountain Rail Road thence down the County road leading from the
Crop Key to Baykins bridge to the turn araby Creek thence down said Creek to said
Mountain Road and thence west said Road to the County Road leading from the
Crop Key to Baykins bridge together with all of the improvements attached to said
land or in any way belonging and said Edward Beaton and his wife Martha doth by
these presents covenant and agree to and with the said John R. Rockelle that they will
by these presents warrant and feaver defend the right and title of the aforesaid land
and improvements of every description attached to the land hereby sold or intended to
be sold by them presents unto him the said John R. Rockelle his heirs and assigns
forever, for their and each of their heirs and every person claiming by or through them
and all and every other person or persons whomsoever the said Edward Beaton
and his wife doth hereby warrant the title of the said land and improvements aforesaid
to the bounds of &c hereby conveyed unto him the said John R. Rockelle and his heirs
forever In Testimony whereof the said Edward Beaton and his wife Martha J Beaton
herby have hereunto set their hands and seals the day and year first above written.
