*This Indenture* made and entered into on this 20<sup>th</sup> day of February year 1843 by Williams Vick Thomas B Worrell and Jacob Barnes all of them of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia, Witnesseth that the said Williams Vick in order to secure to the said Jacob Barnes, the payment of two hundred and seventy five dollars Justly due the said Jacob Barnes appearing as well by bond as this indenture each of Even date with the interest which shall hereafter accrue thereon and the costs of drawing recording and other expenses of carrying into effect this indenture and the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to the said Williams Vick in hand paid by the said Thomas B Worrell at and before the enrolling and delivery of this presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the said Williams Vick hath bargained & sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell all that tract or parcel of land whereon he the said Williams Vick now lives supposed to contain about one hundred acres he the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Fielding J Mason, Jane Holt Patience Vick, Joshua Vick, James Hony and the proprietors of the Mill Road, two featherbeds and furniture, four bed boxes and twenty five one walnut desk of book case two chests, one safe, one cow & calf, one cart & pair wheels To have and to hold the above described land and the above named property and every part and parcel thereof with all the right, title, interest, and estate which he the said Williams Vick hath heretofore held in both the real and personal property herein and hereby conveyed to him the said Thomas B Worrell his heirs and assigns forever. Upon Trust nevertheless that he the said Thomas B Worrell at the request of either party after the expiration of three years next after the date of this indenture indenture shall without delay proceed and sell at auction for Cash all or so much of the above named property real or personal as shall be sufficient to raise money to satisfy the aforesaid debt of two hundred and seventy five dollars with the interest which shall have accrued thereon together with all costs attending the full execution of this trust first advertising the time and place of such sale ten or more days previous thereto and out of the proceeds thereof pay and discharge the said debt interest and costs as aforesaid and of surplus money thereafter remain in the hand of the said Thomas B Worrell the same shall be by him paid over to the said Williams Vick or to such as may be legally entitled to receive the same and if after the payment of the said debt interest and costs as aforesaid any part or all of the property either real or personal above named remain unsold by the said Thomas B Worrell shall release to him the said Williams Vick or to such as are entitled the title hereby conveyed to him.
