This Indenture made and entered into on this 20th day of February year 1843 by and between Bennet Barnett Southampton T. Griffin and Jacob Barnes all of them of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia, Witnesseth that the said Bennet Barnett in order to secure to the said Jacob Barnes the payment of Two hundred & ninety seven dollars & ten cents justly due the said Barnes by bond of even date herewith, with the interest which shall accrue on the aforesaid sum and the costs incurred by this indenture and for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to the said Bennet Barnett in hand paid by the said Jonathan T. Griffin at and before the making and delivery of these presents the full receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the said Bennet Barnett hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Jonathan T. Griffin all the interest which in the said Bennet Barnett has in or to the land whereon he now lives the same land being previously conveyed by said Bennet to Benjamin Brown in trust to secure a debt of two hundred dollars due and owing to the said Barnes which trust deed is of record in the Clerk's Office for the County of Southampton and also the following named property to wit: one negro man slave named Dick four father beds and furniture, twelve chairs parcel of crockery ware, ten and glass ware also three chairs four tables one shot gun, two pots, one kettle two pots, two two pair auditions one pair kitchen one beef four head cattle, twenty head sheep twenty head of hogs one harness or more one two wheel carriage & harness one cart of wheels one dog one plow one common plow, three plow bars and two coulters three axes, one pair iron wedges about one thousand pounds, Bacon about twenty five lbs corn about two thousand pounds for 2000 two thin wheels, three pair cards, about thirty bushels potatoes plantings one pair of plow & cart harness one fork for oil one grind stone To have and to hold the above described interest in land as well as the above named negro slave Dick and all other the said named personal property herein named and hereby conveyed to him the said J. T. Griffin his heirs and assigns forever with all the right title interest and estate which in the said Bennet Barnett has hereof held and enjoyed of in and to the said land, slave and other personal property above described to him the said Jonathan T. Griffin his heirs and assigns forever upon Trust nevertheless that he the said J. T. Griffin shall
