This Indenture made and entered into on this 20th day of February year
1843 by and between Bennett Barrett Jonathan J. Griffin and Jacob Barnes
all of them of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia, witnesseth that the
the said Bennett Barrett in order to secure to the said Jacob Barnes the payment
of Two hundred & fifty seven dollars & ten cents justly due the said Barnes by hand of
even date herewith, with the interest which shall accrue on the aforesaid sum and the
costs incurred by this indenture and for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar
to the said Bennett Barrett in hand paid by the said Jonathan J. Griffin at and before the
executing and delivery of these presents the full receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the
said Bennett Barrett hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain
and sell unto the said Jonathan J. Griffin all the interest which he the said Bennett
Barrett has in or hath land wherein he now lies the same land being previously conveyed
by said Barrett to Benjamin Barnes in trust to secure a debt of two hundred dollars due
and owing to the said Barnes which trust deed is of record in the Clerk's Office for the
County of Southampton and also the following named property to wit one negro man slave
named Dick from father beds and furniture, Tudor chairs parcel of overhanging ware, two
and glass ware also three charts from tables one shot gun, two pots, one kettle two pottrock
two pair audience one pair bed irons one set for herd, cattle, twenty head sheep twenty head
of hogs one horse or mare one two wheel carriage & harness on cart of which one wagon & two
one common plow, three plow horses and two oxen less than oxen, one pair iron wedges about one
thousand pounds Buck about twenty five lbs Corn about two thousand pounds for 2200
two spin wheels, three hair cards, about thirty bushels potash & plantings one Bridle & saddle
parcel plow & cart harness one yoke for one grind stone To have and to hold the above
described interest in land as well as the above named negro slave Dick and all other the above
named personal property herein named and hereby conveyed to him the said J. J. Griffin his
heirs and assigns forever with all the right title interest and estate which he the said
Bennett Barrett has had of or held and enjoyed of in and to the said land, slave and
other personal property above described to him the said Jonathan J. Griffin his heirs
and assigns forever nevertheless that he the said J. J. Griffin shall
