Dromgoole at or before the executing or delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said John Woodson has granted bargained & sold and does by these presents grant bargain and sell and convey unto the said Daniel H. Dromgoole his heirs & assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying around a small log house situated on the Indian Side running south & south lying about a quarter of a mile from where the late Benj. Lamb lived and near where the said Lamb's land comes in the road. containing one acre more or less and lying in easterly direction from the said Benj. Lamb's house and a south course from the corner at the road, the nearest line true to the house and lot here conveyed is a fax and oft pin tree together with all and singular the appurtenances belonging or in any wise appertaining.
