

To witness whereupon that the said Patrick H.Rollings and Henry Booth with their executors and administrators and assigns shall and do after transfer and pay over all the said property to the Elizabeth P.Branch in case she survive the said Thomas Bevan, but if she die before him then unto such persons and persons and at the time and times and such parts and proportions manner and form as she the said Elizabeth P.Branch shall from time to time notwithstanding her coverture by any writing or writings under her hand and seal attested by three or more credible witnesses or by her last will and testament or writing to be by her signed sealed published & declared in the presence of the like number of witnesses direct limit or apparent the intent that the same may not be at the disposal of or subject to the control debts of futurities or engagements of the said Thomas Bevan her intended husband and in default of such directions limiting or apparentment then to Patrick H.Rollings and Henry Booth provided always and it is hereby declared and agreed by and between all the said parties to these presents that in case the said Elizabeth P.Branch (surviving the said Thomas Bevan her intended husband) shall at any time hereafter claim and recover and part or parcel of the real or personal estate & heirs of the said Thomas Bevan or any other person or persons entitled for him shall be liable & responsible or entitled unto at any time during the coverture between them by virtue of her dower or title of Dower at common law or by virtue of her being administrator or entitled to administration of the goods chattels rights and credits of the said Thomas Bevan as aforesaid then and in that case they the said Patrick H.Rollings and Henry Booth their administrators and assigns shall from time to time and at all times from thenceforth stand be & responsible of the said property hereby conveyed & interest for the only benefit of the said Thomas Bevan his executors administrators and assigns any thing in these presents contrived to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding.
