And the said Thomas Bevan doth hereby for and in consideration of the payment of the said sum of four hundred and eight dollars unto the said Elizabeth P. Bevan and also of the payment of the sum of four hundred dollars to him the said Thomas Bevan, as aforesaid and above mentioned, sell assign and quit claim unto the said Thomas Pattlow, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever, all and every the aforesaid right, title and interest as hereinbefore described, and set forth. And the said Thomas Bevan and the said Elizabeth P. Bevan do for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, jointly and severally, hereby covenant agree to warrant and lawfully defend the aforesaid right, title and interest above described and set forth unto him the said Thomas Pattlow his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, against the claim or claims of them the said Thomas Bevan and Elizabeth P. Bevan, their heirs, executors and administrators and all other persons whomsoever. Testimony whereof the said parties of the first part have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals, on the said fifteenth day of March in the year eighteen hundred and forty three.

This Indenture made and executed on this the fifteenth day of March in the year eighteen hundred and forty three, by and between Thomas Bevan and his wife Elizabeth P. Bevan parties of the first part, Thomas P. Pattlow party of the second part, and Thomas Pattlow party of the third part, all of whom, the said parties reside in the County of Southampton and Commonwealth of Virginia Metropolis: That whereas the said Thomas Bevan, by a certain Indenture bearing date on the fourteenth day of March in the year eighteen hundred and forty three, recorded in the County Court Clerk's Office of said County, wherein the said Thomas Bevan, Elizabeth P. Bevan and one Henry Booth & Patrick H. Rollings are named as parties thereto, and to which reference is herein and hereby had and made, did convey all and every the right, title and interest which he, the said Thomas Bevan had theretofore derived, and might then have, and might thereafter have and possess, in any manner, at law and in equity, by means and in right of his wife, the said Elizabeth P. Bevan, of in and to the pecuniary or money part or portion of the estate whereof one Peter Booth (late of said County) did possess. Together with all interest that might theretofore have accrued, and might then be due, or might or should thereafter accrue on the said money part or portion as aforesaid, and which money part or portion is directed by the will of said Peter Booth, recorded
