 horse tract in the report and plat made relative to the lands belonging to the Estate
 of James Smith dec^d together with the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders
 yearly and other unto, issues and profits thereof, and of every part and parcel thereof.
 To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the tenements, hereditaments
 and all and singular other the premises herein mentioned, or intended to be bargained
 and sold, and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and
