MS. INDENTURE made this 19th day of January one thousand eight
 hundred forty three between James Joyner & Nancy his wife of Southampton
 County Va. and Mary Pittman of the County aforesaid, witnesseth that the said
 James Joyner and Nancy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred
 dollars current Money of Virginia to them in hand paid by said Mary Pittman have
 bargained & sold and by these presents doth bargain & sell unto the said Mary Pittman
 her heirs & assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation one hundred
 and fifteen acres by the same more or less, bounded by the known and reputed
 boundary thereof, with all the emoluments houses buildings woodways waterways here
 and thereabouts & appurtenances therunto belonging to have & to hold the said tract or
 parcel of land together with all the other premises before mentioned or intended
 to be bargained & sold with every part and parcel thereof, with every of the rights
 unto the said Mary Pittman her heirs & assigns forever. And the said James Joyner
 & Nancy his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract of land with the above
 premises & appurtenances unto the said Mary Pittman her heirs and assigns forever,
 free from the claims of them the said James Joyner and Nancy his wife & from all
 and every other person whatsoever claiming or demanding the same freely or
 under them, shall & will warrant and forever defend by these presents, In witness
 whereof the said James Joyner and Nancy his wife have hereunto set their hand
 and seals.
