This Indenture made this 24<sup>th</sup> day of December in year one thousand  
eight hundred and forty two between John Holland and Henrietta his wife of the one part  
and James D. Denegre Morris Denegre, Mary V. Denegre & Francis S. Bulb in right  
of his wife Emma late Emma Denegre, who are the heirs of John Denegre L<sup>th</sup> of the other  
part. Witnesseth, that the said John Holland and Henrietta his wife for and in consideration  
of three hundred dollars in hand paid by the John Denegre dec<sup>d</sup> on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of  
August 1836 (but the said Henrietta not then being of lawful age to make this conveyance  
it was agreed between the parties by writing to that effect that a few simple title should  
be made when that event happened) and the said John Holland and Henrietta his wife  
doth acknowledge themselves fully satisfied and paid have granted bargain  
and sold chained enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these presents hath granted bargain  
and sold to the said James D. Denegre and the other distributees aforesaid of John  
Denegre dec<sup>d</sup> to them and their heirs forever, one certain tract or parcel of land  
containing ninety one acres be the same more or less lying in the County of Southampton  
and bounded as follows to wit. By the lands of the late John Denegre now owned by John  
& heirs on the west: north by the Surve. East. John Wick and Robert Hicks and South  
by said said Peter J. Pivers estate; together with all houses ways and water courses  
whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said tract of land
