No have and do hold the aforesaid property hereby conveyed unto him the said Bennet Barrett trustee his heirs and assigns forever and the said Norflet Butler for himself his heirs Executors and adm^r doth hereby covenant ~~and~~ agree to and with the said Bennet Barrett his heirs Executors and assigns that he will by these presents warrant and favour defend the right and title of the above mentioned property against the claims or demands of all and every person or persons whatsoever upon special trust notwithstanding to and for the following intents uses and purposes. That is to say that he the said Bennet Barrett trustee or his legal representative may and shall at any time upon default of payment of the aforesaid sum of Four hundred and ninety seven dollars and fifty cents or any part thereof being thereof requested by either parties or their legal representative shall sell at publick auction all the aforesaid property hereby conveyed or so much thereof as will be sufficient to pay and discharge the above sum of four hundred and ninety seven dollars and fifty cents with the interest which may then be due and all the expenses attending these presents after giving legal notice of the time place of such sale and the over plus if any pay to the said Norflet Butler or his legal representative but if the whole of the above sum shall be punctually paid off and discharged so that no default in payment of no part of the aforesaid sum be made then this indenture to be void and of no effect or else to remain in full force and virtue.
