This Indenture made the sixteenth day of January eighteen hundred & forty three between John D Turner of the County of Northampton and State of North Carolina of the one part & Joseph T. Claud of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia: Witnesseth that the said John D Turner for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand dollars to him in hand paid by the said Joseph T. Claud, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained, & sold and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell and convey unto the said Joseph T. Claud his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land containing seven hundred acres more or less lying in the County of Southampton, and bounded as follows on the East by the land of Thomas Branch and James Jackson on the north by the land of James Jackson on the west by the land now in the possession of Mrs Sarah Turner and Nathaniel Jones' land and on the South by the State line, it being the land given to John D Turner by Capt Edward Turner by will, which lies in the County of Southampton & State of Virginia. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereto belonging to him the said Joseph T. Claud his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Joseph T. Claud his heirs and assigns forever. And the
