

Griffin shall have suffered or about to suffer in consequence of being to be surety for the said William Griffin to the said Joseph Jamer either in whole or in part and then upon this further trust that he the said James Holmes as trustee or his heirs executors and administrators, shall and will so soon after the happening of such default of payment as he the said James Holmes his heirs executors & administrators shall think proper or the said Benjamin Griffin or his legal representative request sell to the highest bidder for ready money the property herein conveyed after advertising the same as he the said James Holmes may think or so much thereof as will be sufficient to satisfy the debt and interest due the said Joseph Jamer and all costs attending the recovery of the same or what sum of money the said Benjamin Griffin shall have paid for the said William Griffin and all other expenses attending the premises and if any overplus pay the same to the said William or his executors & administrators. But if the whole sum shall have been paid off which the said Benjamin Griffin is surety for the said William Griffin for so that no default be made in the payment thereof, then this indenture to be void or else remain full force and virtue. This Indenture made this the 3rd day of February in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred & forty three between Edwin Waller of Louisa his wife of the one part and Thomas Bretlow all of the County of Southampton of the other part Metropolitani: that the said Edwin Waller of Louisa his wife in consideration of the sum of five hundred and eighty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Bretlow the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given granted bargained & sold & by these presents do give grant bargain & sell unto the said Thomas Bretlow and his heirs on certain tract or parcel of land lying & being in the County of Southampton and parish of Nettoway, containing three hundred seventy acres and bounded as follows by the land of Jesse Sanford Robert Griffin Bashanah Sumner & others known as Corbells quarter to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land together with all & singular its appurtenances to him the said Thomas Bretlow his heirs forever and the said Edwin Waller of Louisa his wife their heirs executors and administrators the said tract or parcel of land with all its appurtenances to him the said Thomas Bretlow his heirs & assigns shall & well forever warrant & defend against the claim or claims of any person or persons whatsoever claiming under us.
