This Indenture made this 15th day of March in the year of our Lord 1843
by and between Sally Revel one part Charlotte Revel & mother part (elling) and Jacob Barnes
bargain all of whom reside in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia. Witnesseth that
that they the said Sally Revel and Charlotte Revel in consideration of the sum of Twenty
dollars to each of them in hand paid by the said Jacob Barnes at and before the making
and delivery of these presents (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) have bargained
and sold undly these presents so and each of them doth individually bargain and sell
unto the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns all the right title interest and estate
which they and each of them now have or may ever hereafter have to a certain portion
of land herein described in reversion or conditionally as the legitimate Childing of
John Revel to whom was devised a certain portion of land by his father Notely Revel
by his last Will and Testament for and during the natural life of him the said John
Revel which will is of record in the Clerks Office for the said County of Southampton
which portion of land is now in the quiet possession of the said John Revel in the
said County of Southampton. To have and to hold the said interest with all the
right title interest and estate in any and every way or manner belonging whatsoever
to him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Sally
Revel and Charlotte Revel for them selves their heirs the said interest in said land
with all and singular the said interest in said land before mentioned unto him the
said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the
said Sally Revel and Charlotte Revel or either of them their or either of their
heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall well and do warrant
