Witnesseth that they the said Sally Revel and Charlotte Revel, in consideration of the sum of Twenty dollars to each of them in hand paid by the said Jacob Barnes at and before the making and delivery of these presents (the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and do hereby these presents do and each of them doth individually bargain and sell unto the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns all the right title interest and estate which they and each of them now have or may ever hereafter have to a certain portion of land herein described in reversion or conditionally as the legitimate Childing of John Revel to whom was devised a certain portion of land by his father Holley Revel by his last Will and Testament for and during the natural life of him the said John Revel which will is of record in the Clerk's Office for the said County of Southampton which portion of land is now in the quiet possession of the said John Revel in the said County of Southampton. To have and to hold the said interest with all the right title interest and estate in any and every way or manner belonging whatsoever to him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever.
