This Indenture made and entered into this the 7th day of March 1843 between Peter Lam (P. W.) for the one part John R. Rochelle of the second part and Edward Beaton of the third part, Witnesses that whereas the said Peter Lam stands justly indebted with some Edward Beaton in the sum of fifty seven dollars and ninety one cents, duly bond or note the 7th day of March 1843 and being and desirous to secure the payment thereof with for and in consideration of the property, as well as for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said John R. Rochelle bargained and sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien enfeoffed and confirm unto the said John R. Rochelle his heirs Executors administrators and assigns the following property to wit: one down all mare thirteen head of hogs one feather bed three chairs one pot and all of my house hold furniture ten barrels of corn two stacks of blude fodder and all of my crop made this year viz corn fodder, celt on, peas, and potatoes, to have and to hold the above said personal property unto him the said John R. Rochelle his heirs Executors and administrators for the following trust purposes that is to say that if the said Peter Lam shall fail to pay unto the said Edward Beaton the debt aforesaid due him with interest which may accrue thereon or any part of the said debt and interest when demanded, it shall and may be lawful for the said John R. Rochelle (or in case of his death for his legal personal representative who is hereby authorized to act, upon being thereto required by the said Edward Beaton his Executors administrators or assigns) to make sale of the property aforesaid for cash having given at the least ten days previous notice of the time and place and out of the moneys arising therefrom first pay and satisfy the debt and interest aforesaid in so much thereof as may
