This Indenture made & entered into this 20th day of March in the year 1843. between John K. Rochelle of the first part William L. Overett of the second part and Sampson K. Reese of William L. Rochelle of the third part of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia (Witneseth) that whereas the said John K. Rochelle stands justly indebted to the said Sampson K. Reese of William L. Rochelle to a bond, due to prison Debt Liab^d for James Barnes Inf^t as his the said John K. Rochelle's security in the just and full sum of four hundred & forty three dollars & 93 cents dated and on demand the same day the 5th day of March 1843. and being desirous and willing to secure and save himself the said Sampson K. Reese of William L. Rochelle from suffering or being injured by the said securityship and from all costs that may accrue on the same doth hereby grant bargain & sell and hath by their presents jointly bargained & sold unto the said William L. Overett trustee for the further satisfaction of one dollar to him the said John K. Rochelle in hand paid by the said William L. Overett trustee the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the following property to wit one negro boy named John one negro woman by name Lucy & child my Interest in the four negroes & land of Mrs Mary Atkley which I may be entitled to, a tract or parcel of land lying and contiguous to Boykins Depot containing by estimation twenty acres be the same more or less and a tract of land in the upper part of Dorchester County adjoining the lands of Saml Barham lying on Blens Mill Pond containing twenty or twenty four acres unto him the said William L. Overett for the purpose of securing the said Sampson K. Reese and William L. Rochelle and saving them harmless from paying the aforesaid security debt the said John K. Rochelle doth by these presents covenant and agree to and with the the said William L. Overett that he will warrant and forever defend the clear title of the aforesaid property by
