acknowledged the same to be her act and deed and declared that she had willingly  
signed sealed and delivered the same and that she wished not to retract it.  
Given under our hands and seals this 21<sup>st</sup> day of January 1843.

This Indenture made & entered into this 20<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year  
1843 between John R Rochelle of the first part William L Everett of the second  
part and Sampson LeRouse & William S Rochelle of the third part all of the  
County of Southampton and State of Virginia (Harrison) that whereas the  
said John R Rochelle stands justly indebted to the said Sampson LeRouse  
& William S Rochelle to a bond due to Simon Pope Esq<sup>r</sup> for James Barnes  
Inf<sup>t</sup> as his the said John R Rochelle's security in the just and full sum of  
four hundred & forty three dollars & 93 cents dated and on demand the same day  
the 5<sup>th</sup> day of March 1843 and being desirous and willing to secure and save  
harmless the said Sampson LeRouse & William S Rochelle from suffering or being  
injured by the said security ship and from all costs that may accrue on the  
same doth hereby grant bargain & sell and hath by these presents granted  
bargained & sold unto the said William L Everett trustee for the further consid-  
eration of one dollar to him the said John R Rochelle in hand paid by the  
said William L Everett trustee the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the following  
property to wit one negro boy name John one negro woman by name Lucy &  
child my Servient in the four negroes of land of Mrs Mary Atkely which  
I may be entitled to, a tract or parcel of land lying and contiguous to Boykin  
Dept. containing by estimation twenty acres be the same more or less and a tract  
of land in the upper part of Southampton County adjoining the lands of Saml  
Barham lying on Blows Mill Road containing twenty or twenty four acres unto  
him the said William L Everett for the purposes of securing the said Securi-  
ty and William L Rochelle and saving them harmless from paying the  
aforesaid Security debt the said John Rochelle with by these present  
covenant and agree to and with the the said William L Everett that he  
will warrant and forever defend the said title of the aforesaid property if
