Witnesseth that the said Albert W Nicholson for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and fourteen dollars and sixty six and two thirds cents to him in hand paid by the said George A W Newsom at or before the sealing of delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. hath granted bargained & sold by these presents doth grant bargain sell & convey unto the said George A W Newsom his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton in Raccoon Swamp containing by estimation 2 1/4 3/4 acres be the same more or less. and joining the lands of Warham Wrenn Winchen Jells, George W Bay & others. To have & to hold the said tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances to him the said George A W Newsom his heirs & assigns forever. And the said Albert W Nicholson for himself, his heirs & assigns doth hereby covenant to & with the said George A W Newsom, his heirs & assigns that he the said Albert W Nicholson & his heirs & assigns will forever warrant & defend a good & perfect title to the said lands & its appurtenances against the claim or claims of him the said Albert W Nicholson and all other persons whomsoever.
