This Indenture made this 14th of March 1843, between Thomas C. Jones of the first part and Sheriff of Southampton County of the other, M. Thompson of that shire as the said Thomas C. Jones is now imprisoned under execution in favour of Nathaniel Phillips assignee of Robert Hicks adm^r of Edwin Hicks dec^d for the sum of two hundred and eight dollars 67/100 and whereas the said Thomas is desirous of about to relieve himself by the oath of insolvency, under the aforesaid execution and being required by law to convey to the Sheriff all his Estate as well as to render the same in his schedule hath accented this conveyance, now this indenture witnesseth that the said Thomas before for and in consideration of the premises aforesaid and for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid at the executing of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained sold and delivered by these presents with grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said Sheriff of Southampton County and his assigns forever all the right title interest claim or demands whatever which he hath in or to the following property to wit all the interest which he hath in or to a certain tract or parcel of land near Jerusalem in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing about one hundred and twenty acres, five houses plots in the Town of Jerusalem in the County aforesaid and are the same mentioned in a deed of trust of record in the County of Southampton. To have and to hold the aforesaid granted property to the said Sheriff & his assigns forever. In Witness whereof the said Thomas C.
