Bell her heirs and assigns a certain tract of land Willied to Sarah Harvey by her father Josiah Murdaugh and purchased of the said Sarah Harvey by Joseph C. Murdaugh & Elizabeth C. his wife Together with all the singular tenements, woods, underwoods, water, advantages, emoluments, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract of land belonging or appertaining to the same or any part thereof and the reversion and reversions, remaines and remaines yearly and
